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Paco Puga L'Amitie Robusto Blend 2019

L'Amitié Robusto is crafted by Francisco “Paco” Puga, a winemaker whose career began in Burgundy in 1999 and whose work in the Calchaquí Valley reflects that formative influence. This wine is conceived as a tribute to balance, patience, and terroir, bringing together fruit from four distinct high-altitude sites. Each parcel is vinified separately, spending its first year aging on its own before being united for a second year, allowing complexity to build gradually rather than through force.

The result is a structured yet refined wine, where freshness and depth coexist. Aromatically expressive, it shows ripe dark fruit, subtle herbal tones, and gentle spice, framed by a polished texture and a long, composed finish. A high-altitude expression that favors elegance over excess, and precision over power.

The Vineyards

Grapes are sourced from four different high altitude terroirs in the Calchaquí Valley, averaging 7,500 feet above sea level, where ancient soils, dry conditions, and intense sunlight shape wines of freshness and precision.

Calcu Fotem Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Fotem is a coastal expression born in Marchigüe, within Chile's Colchagua Valley, just 16 miles from the Pacific Ocean. Created by the Hurtado family, whose winemaking history in the region spans more than a century, this wine is the result of a 20 year experiment across 166 hand planted micro plots. Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Carménère come together in a wine that is elegant yet vibrant, shaped by foggy mornings, granite soils with clay seams, and grazing livestock that naturally manage the vineyards. On the palate, Fotem shows ripe blackberries, red plum, and a finely balanced structure with a long, lingering finish. Awarded 94 points by Descorchados and 93 points by James Suckling.

The Vineyards

Viñedos Calcu is located in Marchigüe, Colchagua Valley, on granite hills with clay seams, just 16 miles from the Pacific, where fog, varied slope orientation, and coastal influence shape highly expressive micro plots.

Mas Vilella Red Blend 2021

Mas Vilella 2021 is made at a 16th century Catalonian farmhouse that may sit atop an ancient Roman villa, where amphora and earthenware remnants have been found in the vineyard. Winemaker Albert Jané works with vines planted by his parents in 1984, continuing a family tradition that began in 1914. This wine blends Cabernet Sauvignon with Sumoll, a rare native grape of Penedès that adds earthy, distinctly Mediterranean character. Aromas of dried herbs, creamy oak, and ripe fruit lead to a palate of powerful fruit and spice. Produced organically in limited quantity, only 1,105 cases were made. Awarded multiple 90+ point scores, including 94 Falstaff and 92 Guía Peñín.

The Vineyards

Located in La Bisbal del Penedès, these organically farmed vineyards sit on poor calcareous and rocky soils under a Mediterranean climate, with low yields that favor concentration and long aging potential.

Hispano-Suizas Bassus Pinot Noir 2021

Bodegas Hispano+Suizas is a project led by three friends and wine professionals: Pablo Ossorio and Rafa Navarro, from Spain, and Marc Grin, from Switzerland. The project is based on an exhaustive study of the local Utiel-Requena terroir, climate, varieties, and processes, aiming to achieve the highest possible quality while balancing innovation and respecting historical winemaking in the area. Hispano+Suizas is always looking for the varieties that best adapt to the soils and altitude of Requena, including unexpected choices, like this pinot noir, typically found in cooler and more northerly areas of the world.

The Vineyards

2,300 feet above sea level, with chalky-clay soils. Temperatures range from 14°F to 104°F throughout the year, and the area sees a good amount of sun. The altitude contributes to this wide temperature range; the temperature in the summer also varies widely between day and night.
